PROJECT PURPOSE

Included in the Richland County Penny Transportation Program, the Smith/Rocky Branch Greenway project will provide a new trail connection from the Broad River (just south of I-20) through the Earlewood community to the Olympia community with connections to the University of South Carolina. The purpose of this greenway project is to provide transportation options as well as recreational opportunities to the citizens of Richland County. Bicyclists and pedestrians alike will be able to travel safely along the corridor separated from vehicles. On the northern end, the greenway will also connect to the existing Three Rivers Greenway.

The Smith/Rocky Branch Greenway is funded by the Richland County Penny Program. Identified as a priority in 2012, this greenway project involves a partnership between Richland County, the City of Columbia, and the University of South Carolina. The greenway is divided into 3 segments:

Section A: Link Existing Northern Portion of Three Rivers Greenway to Clement Road.

Section B: Clement Road to Colonial Drive.

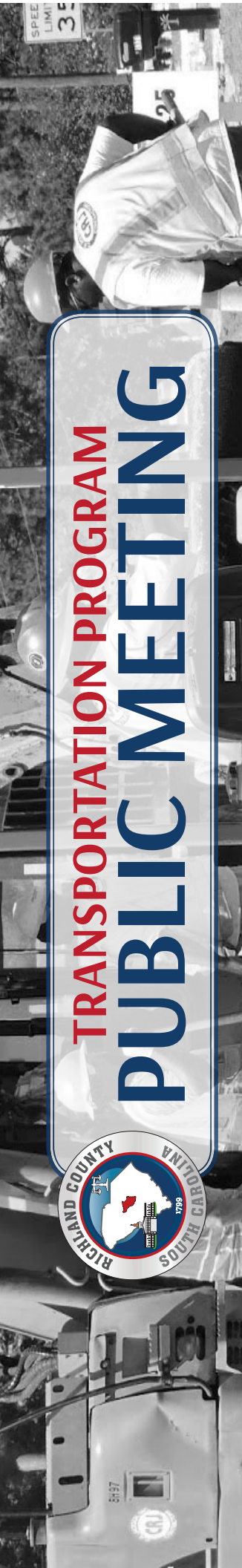
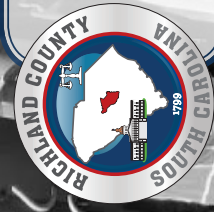
Section C: Rock Branch to Heyward Street.

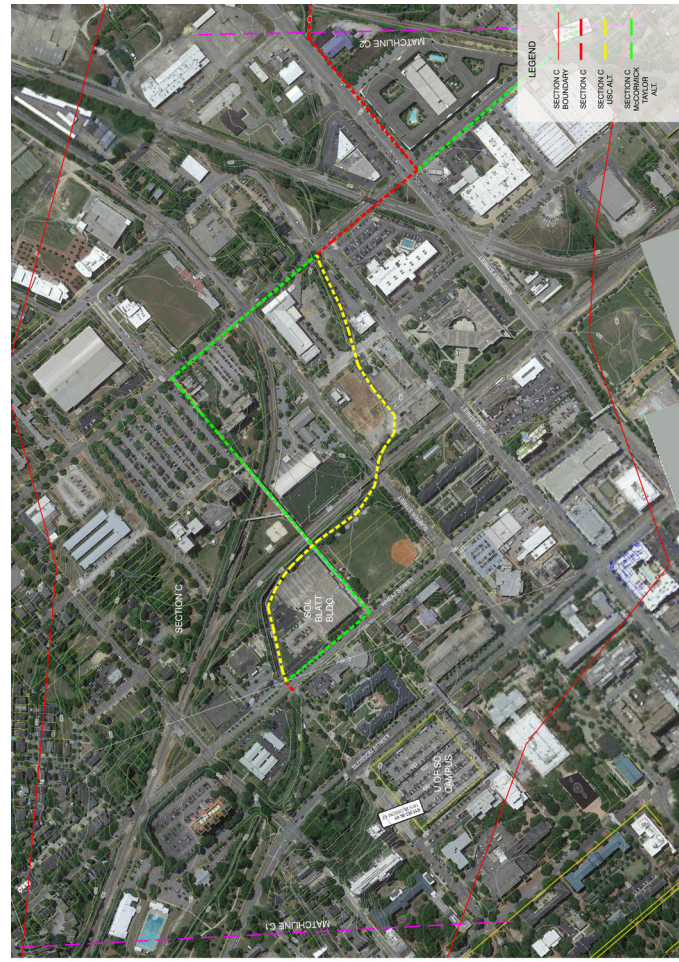
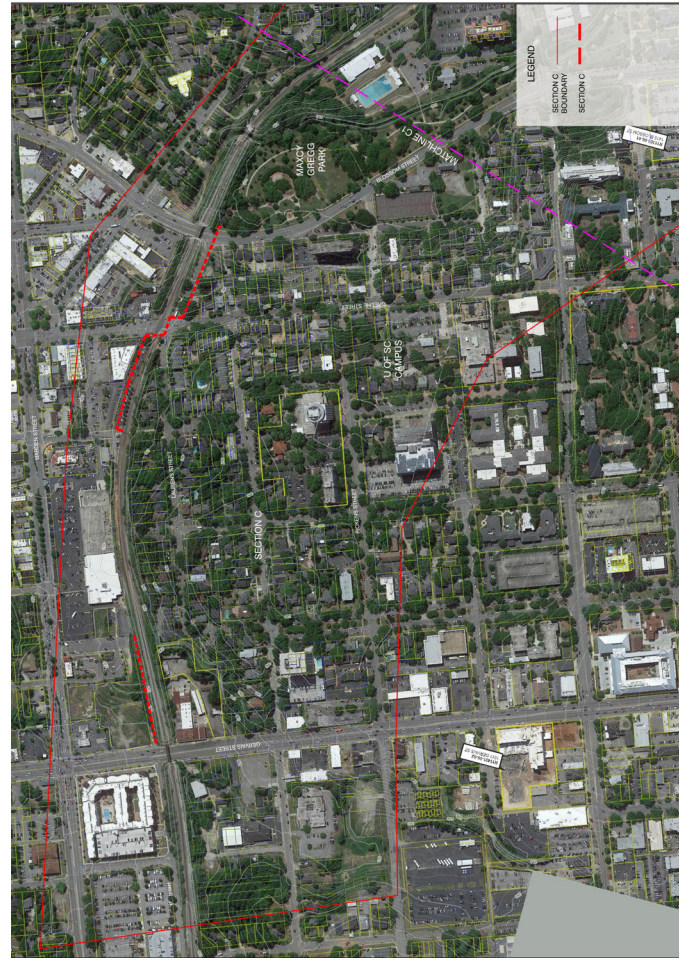
