ABOUT

A watershed is an area of land that drains rainwater, snowmelt, runoff, and groundwater into a single water body such as a stream, river, lake, or ocean. Within a watershed, all the rain, hail, sleet, or snow that falls eventually flows to "One Water" body. Watersheds occur on many scales, from the tiny watershed that feeds a single storm drain in a parking lot all the way up to the giant watershed of the Pacific Ocean, which encompasses large areas of several continents. The way we treat the land in our watersheds and our daily habits can have a big impact on the water we use and drink. We invite you to create a poster to tell your family and friends how and why it is important to practice good conservation habits in your watershed!



HOW TO ENTER

1. Research watersheds and water conservation,. How do you, your friends and your family rely on water? How do our actions affect local watersheds? What can we do to keep water clean and healthy?

2. Sketch out a design that illustrates what you learned! Imagine you are designing an educational billboard -- try to convey your message through illustrations and few words!

3. Transfer your sketch onto a 14"x22" paper and use markers, paints, and other flat media to make it colorful.

4. Attach a completed entry form to the back of your poster.
