Forests are amazing ecosystems that are home to many plants and animals. Forests purify the air we breathe, filter the water we drink, prevent erosion, reduce flooding, and serve as buffers against climate change. Forests also produce a variety of products used by people, including lumber, paper, food, and medicine. We invite you to create a poster illustrating why forests are important, and how we can protect and conserve forests so they will be with us always.

How to Enter

- 1. Learn more about forests and forest ecosystems. Why are forests important? How do they affect the soil, water, air, climate, wildlife, plants, and people? How can we conserve and protect forests?
- 2. Sketch a design to illustrate the beauty, diversity, and importance of forest ecosystems. Include the words "May the Forest Be With You Always" in the poster design.
- 3. Transfer your sketch onto 14"x22" paper and use markers, crayons, colored pencils, paint, or other flat media to make it colorful.
- 4. Attach a completed entry form to the back of your poster.
- 5. Submit your poster to the Richland Soil and Water Conservation District by Friday, April 12, 2024. Contest winners will receive cash prizes!
