

## River Alliance Board

Richland County is a founding member of the River Alliance, which is charged with creating community benefit from 90 miles of the region's rivers. The Alliance is a non-profit corporation, governed by a Board of Directors. Richland County has **THREE** members; two members are Richland County Council and **ONE** is a citizen appointment. The terms are **THREE** years. The citizen appointment must reside in the County. A degree at the undergraduate level is necessary; postgraduate level is desirable. The candidate should be prepared to assist in promoting facilities, services or policies that create citizen benefit from our rivers. Service on committee assignments can be expected. These can include the Public Safety and Security Committee and the Fundraising Committee. The board meets one or two times per year as needed. Occasionally, casual tours of current projects are scheduled; however, attendance is not required. Committee meetings are held on an as needed basis with no more than two or three times per year. All meetings are one hour in length and all meetings place will be given at the time of meeting notification.
