



Beginning Wednesday, Oct. 13, Richland County will begin picking up flood-related debris curbside. (This debris is separate from regular household garbage and recyclables that go in the green and lime green roll carts.) A contractor hired to collect and dispose of flood-related debris will gather and monitor these items.

To help with debris collection, County officials urge residents to properly separate the items into piles – household, construction, vegetation, household hazardous waste, “white” goods with refrigerator/freezer doors secured with duct tape and electronics.
